

15" (38.1cm) Corner to Corner Garter Stitch Blanket



Tension 22sts and 28 rows = 4" (10cm) worked over stocking stitch using 4mm needles and DK yarn

You will need approximately 85 gm of double knitting acrylic yarn to complete this blanket and approximately 20 gm of double knitting acrylic yarn to complete this 2 bonding squares.

Blanket

Using 4mm needles and double knitting yarn

Cast on 1 stitch

Row 1 Knit into front and back of stitch (2 stitches)

Row 2 Slip 1, knit into front and back of next stitch (3 stitches)

Row 3 Slip 1, knit into front and back of next stitch, knit to end (4 stitches)

Repeat last row until the 2 sides of the blanket measure just under 15"

Knit 1 row without any increase

Next row Slip 1, knit 2 together, knit to end of row

Repeat last row until 2 stitches remain.

Knit 2 stitches together, break of yarn and thread through remaining stitch.

Darn in ends

Bonding Squares

Two 5" corner to corner Bonding Squares can be made to match, by increasing until the 2 sides measure just under 5", then completing other 2 sides in same way the blanket pattern.

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
